Clinic Overview

We are open Monday-Friday, with morning walk-in hours. We also offer weekend urgent care clinic. We provide all aspects of routine pediatric care, including well visits, sports physicals, immunizations and sick visits. We manage ADHD, developmental and behavioral health concerns, chronic medical conditions, complex medical issues, and contraception. We offer lactation services for breastfeeding couplets and complimentary prenatal consultations for expectant or new parents. We perform procedures including circumcisions, suturing, incision and drainage, and wart cryotherapy. Our dedicated Care Management Team assists with referrals and the social determinants of health. We use Office Practicum, an electronic health record designed specifically for outpatient pediatrics. Each of our locations has a comprehensive in-house lab that processes Group A strep, Influenza, RSV, and COVID-19 molecular tests, as well as CBC profiles, Monospot tests, cholesterol, glucose, urine dipstick, and urinalysis.

We take pride in our reputation for clinical excellence. We have won numerous awards from the state, including recognition for our outstanding immunization rates. We are active members of Community Care of North Carolina (CCNC), Triad Health Network (THN), and UNC Health Alliance, and have been recognized for our exemplary management of chronic diseases such as asthma, based on our low ED and hospital admission rates. Burlington/Mebane Pediatrics is a preceptor teaching site for Elon University's physician assistant program and UNC School of Medicine's medical students.

Position Overview

We are seeking a motivated, team-spirited BC/BE pediatrician with an unrestricted North Carolina medical license and excellent clinical training for a full-time position (preferred) or part-time position.
